Building upon major NIH-initiated cohort studies and clinical trials, our areas of research focus include inflammatory and immunologic determinants of cardiovascular disease (CVD) including myocardial infarction and stroke; genetic epidemiology studies among multiethnic populations; nutritional epidemiology; and multi-omics research (genomics, transcriptomics, epigenetics, metabolomics). Projects include large cohort studies and collaborations: Hispanic Community Health Study/Study of Latinos/SOL; Women's Interagency HIV Study/WIHS; Nurses' Health Study; Health Professionals Follow-up Study; Cohorts for Heart and Aging Research in Genomic Epidemiology consortium/CHARGE, NIH Trans-Omics for Precision Medicine Program/TOPMed.

**Faculty position:** Seeking junior or senior level applicants who will maintain an independent NIH-funded research portfolio, and teach medical and graduate students. Successful applicants will have a history of high productivity. The position comes with a generous start-up package. Rank will be commensurate with experience.

**Postdoctoral positions:** Seeking highly-motivated applicants with outstanding training in epidemiology, genetics, and/or bioinformatics. While diabetes and CVD are the main focus of our group, individuals with interests in related conditions and risk factors are welcome to apply.
